

BTC Ibérica carries out a thorough responsible procedure regarding the environment in all the productive actions and activities it conducts. In this sense, our basis is the regulation ISO 14.001, which has been properly registered and deals with the environmental management. We continuously carry out activities for the control and minimization of the goods consumed and for the proper management of the waste generated.

This is the waste that can be generated for the customer when receiving the product or once it has finished its life cycle: plastic, cardboard, wood, iron, metal (aluminium and copper) and cable scraps.

Plastic and cardboard can be managed by the local cleaning and garbage collection services. Their residue codes (European Waste List) are the following: 070213 plastic waste; 030308 cardboard and paper waste.

Wood can be managed through recycling centers or through specialized agents. In many cases, it can also be sold or used as a sub product. Its residue code (European Waste List) is the following : 150103 wood

Iron, metal (aluminium and copper) and cable scraps must be managed by agents properly authorized by the appropriate authority. Their residue codes (European Waste List) are the following ones: 191001 Iron and steel waste; 170402 Aluminium; 170401 Copper, Bronze and brass waste; 170411 Cables.
